



We congratulate the Commission for preparing this important document. We believe that the targets proposed in the issues paper are adequate.

We just suggest to improve the formulation of target 3. In the current version, fast reactors, SMRs and cogeneration are mixed in a way, which might be confusing.

We suggest to split Target 3 into following three separate targets:

- _ Target 3a: Fast reactors;
- _ Target 3b: SMRs;
- _ Target 3c: Nuclear cogeneration.

We propose the following formulation of Target 3c:

"Nuclear heat and electricity cogeneration is a low emissions alternative for fossil fuels in industrial heat generation. Therefore it is necessary to progress with its implementation having in mind challenging goals of energy independence and emission reduction. Providing low cost industrial heat is also important for ensuring competitiveness of European industry. Thus, the target is:

- Developing at least one high temperature cogeneration plant by 2030 and demonstrating the efficiency and safety of the coupling to the heat consumer industrial plant. "
